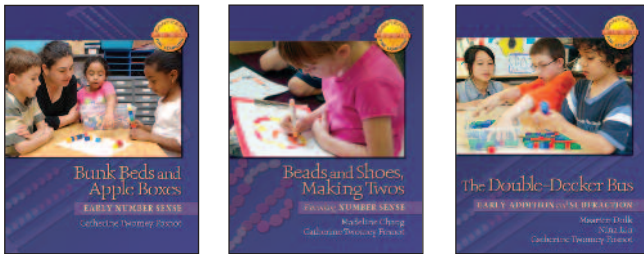




# Teacher Packs

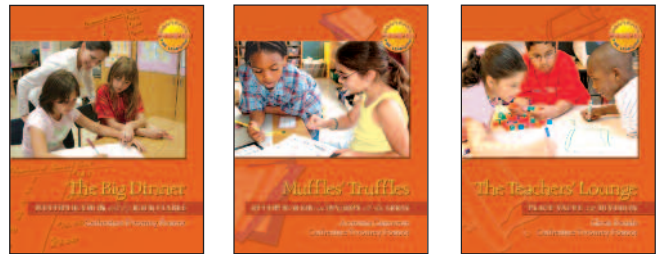

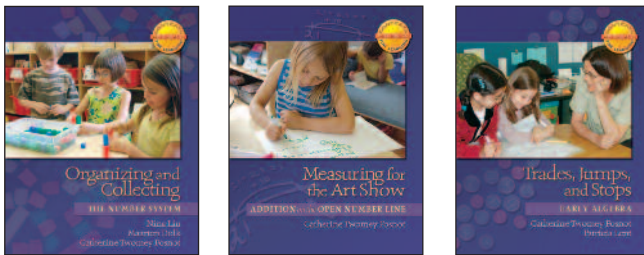

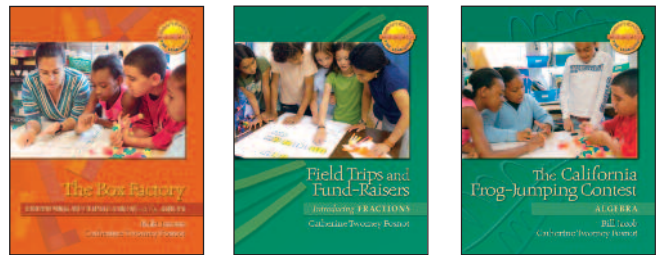

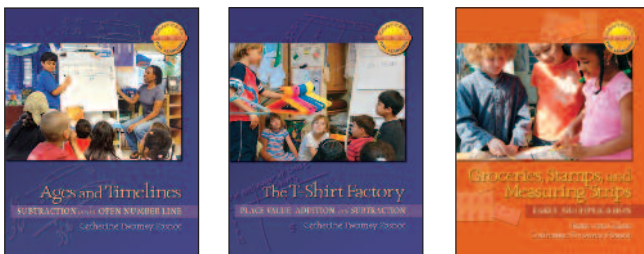
